Pre-K students will begin classes on September 14, 2020. This will be a challenging school year for students, parents and teachers due to the COVID-19 virus. We ask for the patience, cooperation and understanding of all parents and families as we begin the new school year. The Fairview School District is committed to providing a safe and healthy learning environment for all students, teachers and staff. The Fairview School District is proud to provide a quality elementary education to our students. The district will purchase 300 new chrome books this year to increase the technology available to our students for remote/virtual instruction and will provide internet access to families in need through hotspots from local phone and cable companies.
