**Job Description: Art Teacher**

**Reports to:** Principal, supervisor

**Job Goal:**

Partner with teaching staff in the development of student artistic ability through the administration of the art program; to provide specialized instruction to students and to oversee the selection, organization, utilization and maintenance of art resources in the district.

**Qualifications:** N. J. Standard Certification as Art Teacher or CEAS, CE

Must pass a criminal history background check (CHR) and have a physical examination by a doctor using the district physical examination form.

**Education and/or Experience:**

Bachelor of Arts degree or higher

**Evaluation:**

Teachers are evaluated on their performance using the Achieve NJ Teacher Evaluation components; Teacher Practice and Student Achievement and for select teachers, Student Growth Percentiles. Performance of this job will be evaluated two or three times annually in accordance with state law and the provisions on the Board's policy on evaluation of certificated personnel.

**Essential Duties and Responsibilities:**

- Collaborates with teachers to provide art instruction and support student learning goals.
- Reinforce curricular programs and help students make meaning from various resources; supports students' interaction with a variety of art genre as reflected in district curricula.
- Develops and maintains a diversified art collection of print, non-print and resources to support curricular needs, the artistic interests of students.
- Maintains equipment, materials and supplies
- All other duties as assigned by your immediate supervisor and/or principal.

**Other Job Duties:**

- Serves as a resource person to school teams and works on special projects as assigned
- Participates in continuing education programs for professional growth including in-service courses and meetings as required.

- Serves as a member of the art department of the school and district performs related duties consistent with the scope and intent of the position as assigned.

**Qualification Requirements:**

The art teacher must demonstrate a successful level of the knowledge, skills and abilities listed below:

- Knowledge of instructional strategies for teaching and facilitating art.
- Knowledge of current professional trends in art history and techniques.
- Ability to partner with other staff to design and implement effective instruction; classroom management skills.
- Ability to maintain art supplies and equipment as needed.
- Ability to establish and maintain effective working relationships with students, parents, other school employees and others as needed.
- Ability to maintain accurate records and reports.
- Ability to communicate effectively.
- Ability to be flexible and adaptable.
- Ability to work as part of a team.
