Job Description: Physical Education/Health Teacher

Reports to: Principal, supervisor

Job Goal:

Work as a teacher in the development of student's physical ability and health through the administration of the physical education/health program; to provide specialized instruction to students and to oversee the selection, organization, utilization and maintenance of physical education resources and equipment in the district.

Qualifications: N. J. Standard Certification as Physical Education/Health Teacher or CEAS, CE
Must pass a criminal history background check (CHR) and have a physical examination by a doctor using the district physical examination form.

Education and/or Experience:

Bachelor of Arts degree or higher

Evaluation:

Teachers are evaluated on their performance using the Achieve NJ Teacher Evaluation components; Teacher Practice and Student Achievement and for select teachers, Student Growth Percentiles. Performance of this job will be evaluated two or three times annually in accordance with state law and the provisions on the Board's policy on evaluation of certificated personnel.

Essential Duties and Responsibilities:

- Provides physical education/health instruction and support student learning goals.
- Reinforce curricular programs and help students make meaning from various resources; supports students' interaction with a variety of physical education/health activities reflected in district curricula.
- Develops and maintains a diversified collection of physical education resources to support curricular needs, the development of students' interest in physical education/health.
- Maintains equipment, materials and physical education supplies.
- All other duties as assigned by your immediate supervisor and/or principal.

Other Job Duties:

- Serves as a resource person to school teams and works on special projects as assigned

- Participates in continuing education programs for professional growth including in-service courses and meetings as required.
- Serves as a member of the physical education/health department of the school and district performs related duties consistent with the scope and intent of the position as assigned.

Qualification Requirements:

The physical education/health teacher must demonstrate a successful level of the knowledge, skills and abilities listed below:

- Knowledge of instructional strategies for teaching and facilitating physical education/health.
- Knowledge of current professional trends in physical education/health education.
- Ability to design and implement effective instruction; classroom management skills.
- Ability to maintain physical education supplies and equipment as needed.
- Ability to establish and maintain effective working relationships with students, parents, other school employees and others as needed.
- Ability to maintain accurate records and reports.
- Ability to communicate effectively.
- Ability to be flexible and adaptable.
- Ability to work as part of a team.
