

## **Public Notice – Superintendent, Business Administrator Contract Hearing**

Pursuant to N.J.S.A. 18A:11-11, the Fairview Board of Education (hereinafter the “Board”) is providing notice of its intent to hold a public hearing and to take action to amend, extend, renegotiate and/or alter contract terms and conditions of the district Superintendent and Business Administrator at its regular meeting to be held on May 10, 2022 at 6:00 PM.

Section 5 of the Act amended N.J.S.A. 18A: 11-11 to require boards of education to provide public notice 30 days prior to the renegotiation, extension, amendment, or alteration of an employment contract with the superintendent of schools and assistant superintendent of schools, school business administrator; and WHEREAS, Said public notice was provided to the public via posting in the office of the Board Secretary located at 130 Hamilton Avenue, Fairview, NJ 07022 on May 10, 2022, and on the district’s public website.

Section 5 of the Act amended N.J.S.A. 18A: 11-11 to require boards of education to provide public notice of a public hearing 10 days prior to the renegotiation, extension, amendment, or alteration of an employment contract with the superintendent of schools, assistant superintendent of schools, or school business administrator; and WHEREAS, Said public notice of a public hearing will be provided to the public via posting in the office of the Board Secretary located at 130 Hamilton Avenue, Fairview, NJ 07022 on May 24, 2022, and on the district’s public website on May 24, 2022;

The Fairview Board of Education hereby designates starting at 6:00 P.M. on June 14, 2022 as the public hearing required by the Act, after which the Board may take action to renegotiate the Superintendent’s contract and Business Administrator’s contract.

Prior to this action the Board will permit the public to make comment on the proposed contract addendum at the aforementioned meeting. The Board, pursuant to Open Public Meetings Act, specifically N.J.S.A. 10:4-12 (b), shall not publicly discuss personnel matters. However, the Board will give all comments appropriate consideration. Copies of this contract are available for review by contacting Mrs. Rita Juliano, Board Secretary.

The Board, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 10:4-12 (b), the Open Public Meeting Act, shall not publicly discuss personnel matters and shall not respond to comments made by members of the public.

Please be aware that the subject of this hearing retains the right of privacy and shall retain all rights regarding defamation and slander according to the laws of New Jersey. The Board shall not be held liable for comments made by members of the public.
