The Fairview district is pleased to announce that we are installing new HVAC units in Lincoln School and Number Three School beginning in June 2022, which will improve air quality, ventilation, air filtration, heating and air conditioning in these buildings. The Fairview School District is proud to provide a quality elementary education to our students. The district now has one chrome book for each student in grades PK-8. We also upgraded our internet infrastructure this year and are happy to provide safe and reliable internet access to all of our schools and students. The district is planning to install additional security cameras in district schools during the 2022-2023 school year, and will continue to employ full-time security officers in all of our schools, which will enhance the security of the buildings and grounds.

The community of Fairview is approximately one square mile in size, located in Bergen County, N.J. There are four elementary schools in our PK-8 district with an enrollment of approximately 1,600 students. The Fairview School District offers a breakfast and lunch program, extended-day program, summer school program and an after-care program for all students. This year the district is planning to offer all of these programs. We sincerely hope that the district will not have to limit any of these programs due to restrictions caused by the COVID-19 virus.
